Liturgical Jottings

Ascension Communicantes Eucharistic Prayer I (the Roman Canon) has special insertions for the major solemnities. Called "Proper Forms of the Communicantes" the prayer within the Eucharistic prayer which begins with: "In communion with those whose memory we venerate" has a variation for the Feast of the Ascension.

"Celebrating the most sacred day on which your Only Begotten Son, our Lord, placed at the right hand of your glory our weak human nature, which he had united to himself, and in communion with those whose memory we venerate, especially the glorious ever-Virgin Mary, ..."

The prayer is addressed to the Father, calls to mind the mystery of Christ's incarnation, unity with humanity, ascension into heaven and his glorious reign within the Godhead.

There is also a proper form of the *Communicantes* for the feast of Pentecost when using the Roman Canon. These insertions are not in the other Eucharistic Prayers.

Looking at the Readings

"O breathe on me, breath of God, Fill me with life a-new" is a classical hymn written by Edwin Hatch in 1878 and published in 321 hymn books. Each verse begins with the same words: "Breathe on me, breath of God. The breath of God is heard at the dawn of creation (Gen 1:2; 2:7), it enlivens the dry bones in Ezekiel's vision (Ezek 37:9-10 – the vigil of Pentecost third reading) and Jesus breathes on the apostles to receive the Holy Spirit (John 20:22, Gospel) The breath of God is life-giving, renewing and it symbolises the coming of the Holy Spirit. Pentecost commemorates the marvellous acts of God from creation, resurrection of Christ, the inauguration of the new covenant and the birth of the Church.

The liturgy of Pentecost transcends time by constantly making present the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, the gifts of the Spirit and the graces of the mystery on each one of us. The readings of the Liturgy of the Word are very familiar to us. May we hear them anew and let the words refresh us in our faith and actions.

Prayer to the Holy Spirit

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and enkindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And you shall renew the face of the earth.

Let us not doubt that when on Pentecost the Holy Spirit filled the Lord's disciples, he was not giving his gift for the first time but was rather extending a gift already given. The patriarchs, the prophets, the priests, and all the saints of earlier times were nourished by the same sanctifying spirit. No sacrament was ever instituted, no mystery ever celebrated, that did not involve his grace. 


